We are looking for new partners to share good practices in a Leonardo da Vinci Partnership project.

New tools for assessing prior learning have been developed in a Leonardo da Vinci project TES*. The Assessment Resource Pack can be used e.g. in careers counselling, in planning education paths or individual study programmes both for native and immigrant adult learners in vocational education and training.

Target group

VET in adult education

The aim of the proposal

Sharing good practices and learning from each other in workshops for teaching staff in vocational adult education.

Focus

- What kind of methods, tools or resources does a partner organisation have for identifying prior learning?
- What kind of methods or tools are applicable in working life?
- What are the best practices related to identifying prior learning of immigrants?
- Plans for future cooperation and preparing a project proposal in a Leonardo Transversal Programme

Funding of the Partnership project

Each partner apply funding for their own costs from partner's own National Leonardo Agency. A joint application will be prepared by the coordinator.

Duration of the project

2 years: October 2009 – September 2011. Application deadline in February 2009.

Coordinator

The coordinating partner **Jyväskylä University of Applied Sciences, Teacher Training College** will prepare a preliminary proposal that all partners can use as an application to be sent to their own National Agency.
